Personal Application and Group Interaction:

What stands out about Paul's prayer? What does it encourage in your thinking about how you pray and what you pray for?

Why do you think Paul would place knowledge and discernment together in verse 9? When has this impacted your life and maturity?

Verse 10 deals with approving what is excellent. What has your journey been like in this regard? Are their things you would or would not approve today that you did earlier in your walk with God? Why?

There is fruit or results that should flow from us as Christians. What kind of fruit did you produce today? Start by thinking of your day from beginning to the end. Does this show you areas of your heart, attitude, and actions of what kind of fruit is most productive in your soul?
