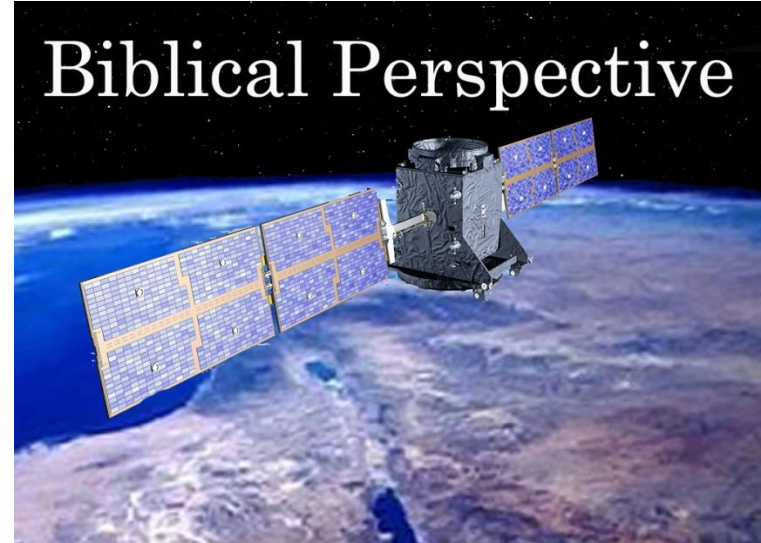


Personal Application and Group Interaction:
