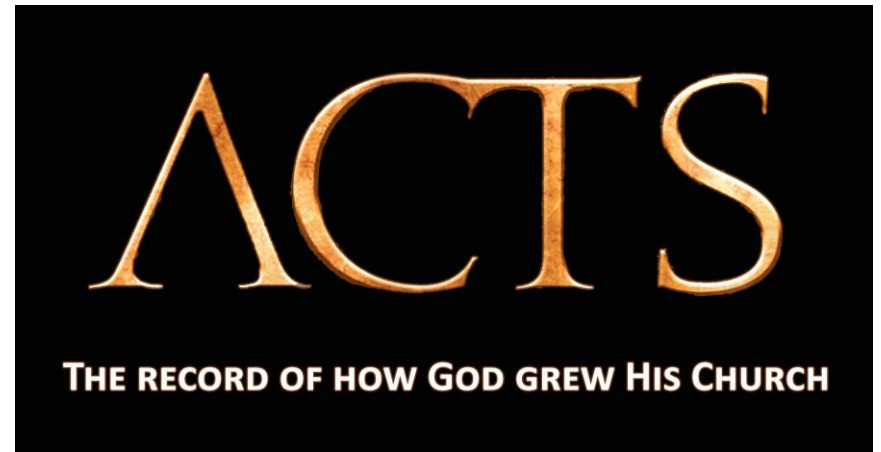


Personal Application and Interaction
