The enemy wants to devour everyone. And God has placed us in enemy territory. What will we do to get the message out there? What will we say? Where to from here?

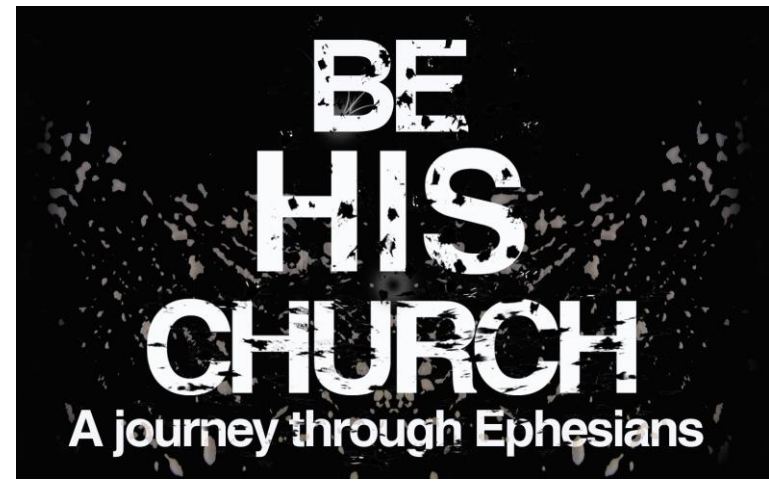
