4. What important principles did you learn from the connection between the rejection of Jesus in Nazareth and the sending out of the disciples?
5. What does “traveling light” (vs.8-11) look like to you? Why do you think Jesus required that lifestyle of the Twelve when He sent them out ***“to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick”*** (Lk.9:1-6)? How do those instructions apply to us?
