I find myself praying a familiar prayer for people. I pray they will lean on the Lord, turn to Him and call on Him. Reflect for a moment on a time when you called on Jesus. What did you experience? Did you find Him to be receptive? Were you keenly aware of His presence? Where did He take you, what did He show you, and how did you know you were following Him through it all? What difference has it made in your life when you've called on Him?
