How might the message of Romans help you clarify salvation to a friend?

How has the book of Romans been used by God to help you to "be transformed" (Romans 12:1-2)?

Paul said he would rather be banished to hell than see his people (the Jews) suffer an eternity without Christ's salvation. How do you identify with this kind of passion for people?
